Don't Get Caught In The Blind Spot!

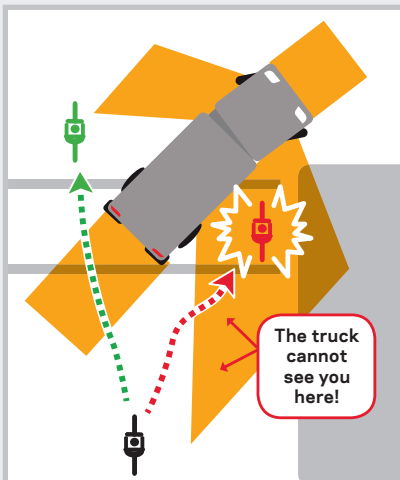

Do & Learn:

- Come sit in a truck and see what the truck driver can see.
- Learn how to safely use the streets while walking or biking near trucks.
- Large trucks and buses have blind spots in the front, back and sides of their vehicles where pedestrians and bicyclists cannot be seen by the driver.
- Never play around a truck—even when it is stopped.
- Always stay on the sidewalk or in the bike lane.
- If possible, try to see the driver in the vehicle's mirrors. If you can see the driver, the driver can see you.

DON'T GET CAUGHT IN THE BLIND SPOT



Stay out of blind spots and watch for truck turns before proceeding through the intersection.
Keep your distance when trucks are turning.
